POPS – Driver Diagram

Aim/Outcome

Improve outcomes and reduce variations in care for acute laparotomy and peripheral vascular patients within 1 year of commencing the project.

Measures

- Reduction in time to surgery in particular peripheral vascular surgery patients.
- 2. Reduction in minor & major complications.
- 3. Return to theatre.
- 4. Reduce re-admission rates.
- 5. Reduce LOS.

Primary Drivers

Establish a dedicated POPS team to review potential patients for acute surgery.

Pre-operatively

- Identify acute surgical patients early
- 2. Create a POPS Pathway to highlight core considerations in optimising patients medical conditions

Post-operatively

- 1. Emergency laparotomy NELA Pathway for general surgical patients.
- Perioperative peripheral vascular pathway (standard/enhanced) for Vascular patients

Secondary Drivers

Education & training of ward nurses and junior doctors

Post-operative daily review of patients

Daily POPS board round

?? Geriatrician run clinic.

Daily evening handover with POPS team and CCOT

Data Collection & review at 6-months

Change ideas

Accepting and encouraging GP referrals?

Encourage MDT to refer & patients to self refer?
